beneath the snow.






Male red-winged blackbirds may be returning. They make quite a racket as they choose nesting territories.

FEBRUARY






Wood turtles emerge from streams. They stay near streams at first but will gradually expand their foraging area over the next couple of weeks.




Grassland birds nest most successfully if mowing can be postponed till August 20, but an early first batch of nestlings are likely to have fledged by July 20.


